BILL NO. 61-24 – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Anne Arundel County Transit Development Plan 2024 – FOR the purpose of adopting the “Anne Arundel County Transit Development Plan 2024”; and generally relating to the “Anne Arundel County Transit Development Plan 2024”

BILL NO. 62-24 – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Sylvan View on the Magothy Special Community Benefit District – Approval of Loan and Assignment Agreement – FOR the purpose of obligating the County to levy the special tax known as the special community benefit assessment on the Sylvan View on the Magothy Special Community Benefit District in an amount sufficient to repay a loan from Sandy Spring Bank to the Sylvan View Community Association, Inc. in each of up to fifteen (15) fiscal years during the term of the loan; and

BILL NO. 30-24 (As Amended) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning – Planned Unit Developments – Community and Employment – FOR the purpose of adding definitions for ‘planned unit development’, ‘community planned unit development, and ‘employment planned unit development’; adding grandfathering provisions related to certain applications for a planned use development; allowing “planned unit development, community” as a special exception use in certain residential districts; allowing “planned unit development, employment, located on a mining reclamation site” as a conditional use in certain residential, commercial, and industrial districts; allowing “planned unit development, employment, located in the BWI/Ft. Meade growth area” as a special exception use in W1 industrial districts; adding the conditional use requirement for “planned unit development, community”; adding the special exception use requirement for “planned unit developments, community and employment”; providing for the uses, density, bulk regulations and other requirements of planned unit development as a special use; and generally relating to zoning.

BILL NO. 31-24 (As Amended) (Amendment Proposed) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Pensions – Reemployment – Reduction of Benefits – FOR the purpose of

eliminating a reduction in pension benefit during a pension recipient's period of reemployment under certain circumstances; and generally relating to pensions.

BILL NO. 49-24 (Hearing Concluded) (Eligible for Vote) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Employee Retirement Savings Plan – Contractual School Health Employees – FOR the purpose of allowing certain contractual school health employees to participate in the County's Employee Retirement Savings Plan; and generally relating to personnel.

BILL NO. 51-24 (As Amended) (Amendment Proposed) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Classification and Pay Plans – Classified Service and Exempt Service – Public Ethics – Financial Disclosure – FOR the purpose of modifying pay at hire for certain represented employees; modifying leave accrual for certain represented employees; requiring certain employees to file financial disclosure statements; approving the Personnel Officer's Classification and Pay Plans; providing for pay increases for certain employees; providing for advancement to new rate of pay for certain employees; providing for lump sum payments for certain employees; confirming applicability of certain terms related to pay in memoranda of agreements; providing for certain salary adjustments for certain classified employees based on salary compression; applying certain provisions of this Ordinance retroactively; providing for application of this Ordinance; and generally relating to personnel, public ethics, and the Personnel Officer's Classification and Pay Plans.

BILL NO. 52-24 (As Amended) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Budget and Finance – Grants Special Revenue Fund – Conditional Appropriation of Grants – FOR the purpose of allowing appropriations of certain grants to the Grants Special Revenue Fund and County matching funds under certain conditions; and generally relating to finance, taxation, and budget.

BILL NO. 54-24 (Amendments Proposed) – AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Fourth Quarter Fund Transfer and Supplementary Appropriations – FOR the purpose of transferring appropriations of funds between certain offices, departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies in the general

fund; making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated revenues to certain offices, departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies in the general fund and to certain special funds of the County government for the current fiscal year; making this Ordinance an emergency measure; and generally relating to transferring appropriations of funds and making supplementary appropriations of funds to the current expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

[BILL NO. 57-24](#) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning – Critical Area Overlay – Resource Conservation Area – Agritourism, Farm or Agricultural Heritage Site Special Events, and Farm or Agricultural Heritage Site Stays – FOR the purpose of adding certain requirements for temporary, conditional and special exception uses for agritourism, certain farm or agricultural heritage site special events, and farm or agricultural heritage site stays in the Critical Area and the Resource Conservation Area (“RCA”); allowing agritourism, farm or agricultural heritage site special events, and farm or agricultural heritage site stays as uses in the RCA; making the effective date of this Ordinance contingent on the approval of the Maryland Critical Area Commission; and generally relating to zoning.

as amended by this Ordinance; and generally relating to the “Anne Arundel County Region 4 Plan”.
