[BILL NO. 95-24](#) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Public Ethics – Conflicts of Interest – County Council – FOR the purpose of amending the definition of “legislative action”; adding a definition for “participation”; expanding the types of presumed conflicts of interest that would prohibit a Councilmember from participating in legislative action to include Councilmembers and their immediate family members; and generally relating to public ethics.

[BILL NO. 96-24](#) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Subdivision and Development – Site Development – Pre-built Short-term Buildings – FOR the purpose of adding an exemption to the site development plan process to permit pre-built short-term buildings to be placed at religious or educational facilities; and generally relating to subdivision and development.

[BILL NO. 97-24](#) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning – Requirements for Conditional Uses – School Bus Facilities – FOR the purpose of allowing school bus facilities in C1 zoning districts as a conditional use; requiring vehicular access for school bus facilities by certain roads in C1 and C3 zoning districts; requiring a minimum lot size for school bus facilities in C1 zoning districts; and generally relating to zoning.

[BILL NO. 93-24](#) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Planning and Development – Master Plan for Water Supply and Sewerage Systems – FOR the purpose of amending the Master Plan for Water Supply and Sewerage Systems, 2022, to alter certain text and maps; and generally relating to the Master Plan for Water Supply and Sewerage Systems.

the Agriculture Commission; reorganizing Article 3 of the County Code and correcting internal County Code references to the provisions of Article 3 and Article 4; and generally relating to boards, commissions, and similar bodies and finance, taxation and budget.
